BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

The Federation of Youth Clubs of Armenia (FYCA) was established in 1999 and registered as a NGO in 2000. **Today FYCA unites more than 100 youth professional and regional clubs, centers, initiatives, youth informal groups and organizations throughout Armenia, thus becoming the largest youth NGO in the country.**

FYCA's mission is to raise the role of the young generation in the processes of strengthening civil society by uniting youth clubs, fostering active citizenship, and promoting youth participation in democratic development. Through non-formal education, international cooperation, and support for local initiatives, FYCA empowers young people to become agents of positive change in their communities while preserving national values and promoting sustainable development.

Main Objectives:

- ✓ Unite youth clubs, promote open youth work, develop club movements and youth information networks
- ✓ Encourage youth participation in decision-making processes, active citizenship, and support youth policy development and implementation
- ✓ Establish and expand cooperation with international, foreign, and Diaspora youth organizations; promote international programs and intercultural dialogue
- ✓ Promote human rights protection, strengthen democracy, develop electoral systems, and raise awareness about human rights among youth
- ✓ Contribute to improving education quality, its continuity and reforms; support youth in gaining experience and career guidance
- ✓ Encourage volunteer work and support youth initiatives
- ✓ Promote national-spiritual values and traditions; popularize culture and creativity among youth
- ✓ Support rural youth capacity building and creative growth; expand youth services in regions and implement local projects
- ✓ Develop and implement projects for socially vulnerable groups and youth with disabilities; promote social inclusion and develop social work
- ✓ Contribute to environmental protection, promote sustainable human development concepts, and encourage healthy lifestyles
- ✓ Develop entrepreneurial skills among youth, support social entrepreneurship ideas and youth engagement
- ✓ Apply non-formal education methods in youth work, organise training courses, seminars, conferences, festivals, exhibitions, camps, campaigns, and other events and projects; conduct research and publications. We cooperate with state and local authorities, international and foreign similar organisations, and other structures.

FYCA closely cooperates with dozens of foreign and international organizations, has numerous stable partner institutions. **FYCA is a member of the ECYC, MIJARC Europe, Y-E-N, WostAYN, YEE, IYNF and many other international organizations and networks.**

Fields of interest: intercultural learning, international cooperation, non-formal education, open youth work, development and promotion of youth clubs, human rights education, democracy, civic participation, social inclusion, gender equality, youth work in conflict areas, peace-building, regional integration, tolerance, development of entrepreneurship skills, club management, ecology, healthy lifestyle, sustainable development, tourism development, volunteerism, research and publications.

As the largest youth organization of Armenia, FYCA is dealing with the topics which are interesting for the member clubs and youth in general. During the last decades, FYCA has implemented dozens of local, national and international projects, focused on the topic of non-formal education, open youth work, human rights education, civic active citizenship, youth participation, democracy, regional integration, social inclusion of youngsters living in rural areas and so on. According to the data of the last five years, FYCA is leading with the quantity of implemented international youth projects, providing an opportunity to thousands of young people to participate in youth projects in Armenia and abroad.

Our team is composed of 12 professionals in areas such as youth work development, non formal education, public relations and communication, project management, fundraising and international affairs who work every day to create better conditions for the young generation.

What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this project?

FYCA empowers Armenian youth to actively engage in democratic processes through:

Civic Education Programs: Workshops on civic rights, responsibilities, and democratic values, tailored for rural and urban youth. Topics include understanding local governance, electoral processes, and advocacy strategies.

Youth Clubs as Democratic Hubs: Over 100 youth clubs nationwide serve as platforms for dialogue, debate, and collaboration, fostering a culture of active citizenship. These clubs organize town halls, debates and elections, policy discussions, enabling youth to voice concerns and influence decision-making.

Youth Leadership Training: Projects like "*Youth Ambassadors for Democracy*" train young leaders in advocacy, public speaking, and project management. Participants design community initiatives (e.g., environmental campaigns, anti-corruption projects) that address local governance challenges.

Advocacy Campaigns: FYCA supports youth-led campaigns on issues such as gender equality, education reform, and environmental sustainability. For example, the "*Green Voice*" initiative mobilized youth to advocate for climate policies in municipal councils.

Collaboration with Local Governments: FYCA partners with municipalities to integrate youth perspectives into policymaking. In regions like Syunik, Lori and Shirak, youth councils advise local authorities on issues affecting young people, such as employment and infrastructure.

National Youth Networks: FYCA coordinates the "*United Youth – Step Forward*" network, uniting 8,000+ members to amplify youth voices in national dialogues on education, social justice, and democratic reforms.

International Projects: FYCA participates in Erasmus+ programs fostering exchanges on democratic governance, human rights, and intercultural dialogue between Armenian and European youth. FYCA collaborates with European organizations to share best practices and advocate for youth inclusion in Eastern Partnership initiatives. FYCA also hosts European volunteers, promoting mutual learning on civic engagement.

Online Civic Platforms: FYCA's digital resources educate youth on EU institutions, democratic principles, and cross-border collaboration. The "*kamavor.org*" platform equips young activists with tools for recognition of youth work and volunteering, online advocacy and grassroots mobilization.

Social Media Campaigns: Initiatives like *#YouthDecide* use social media to engage youth in discussions on legislative reforms in the fields of education and youth affairs, Armenia's EU association agenda and European integration.

Grassroots Reach and Social Inclusion: FYCA engages 25,000+ youth annually, with 60% from rural/marginalized areas, ensuring inclusive participation. FYCA with its member clubs is doing a lot of work towards the social integration of forcibly displaced young people from Nagorno-Karabakh in 2023.

Policy Influence: FYCA-led youth consultations contributed to Armenia's *National Youth Strategy*, prioritising youth inclusion in governance. In this regard, FYCA also actively participates in various platforms and civic coalitions in order to raise the issues of young people and provide solutions at the state level.

As a conclusion: FYCA's decades of experience in grassroots mobilization, civic education, and cross-border collaboration position it as a key driver of youth democratic participation in Armenia and Europe. By bridging local action with European partnerships, FYCA empowers youth to shape inclusive, democratic futures for their communities and beyond.

Sustainability

Participation in this project will contribute to the long-term development of FYCA and involved organizations by strengthening our global network of professionals, youth workers, and partners. This expanded network is the heart of our interventions since it enables us to provide support to youth workers even after the project's conclusion, following the sustainability model of our programs. At FYCA, our programs are not designed just to achieve short-term objectives but also to offer continuous support to youth workers, ensuring they feel supported even after the intervention ends.

We go beyond the classroom and training sessions by creating ongoing, personalized

support for youth workers and young people in general. Here we rely on a lot in the digital tools we have created up to the date. Our approach connects participants to a broader community of educators, youth workers, and professionals who can assist them in overcoming the various challenges they face throughout their journey. This consistent engagement ensures that youth workers are not left to face obstacles alone; instead, they benefit from an active, global network that remains committed to their success beyond the project's duration. This model is crucial for fostering long-term sustainability.

In addition to this, we will focus on the development of new local partnerships, which will be instrumental in ensuring the continuity and expansion of the project's impact. Throughout the project we will create strategic consortiums that can address emerging challenges and create referral channels for participants, connecting them to ongoing opportunities for youth development. Our goal is to establish a system where the benefits of the project extend long beyond its conclusion, fostering the development of sustainable educators and youth workers who can support themselves, their communities over the long term.

Impact

This project will enable us to reach new vulnerable groups with new programs in areas where we have not yet reached, helping us to expand our global network and broaden our organizational impact. The project will also provide us with the opportunity to continually enhance our digital platforms, ensuring they become progressively more intuitive and accessible for young people. By making these platforms more user-friendly and inclusive, we will empower a youth community to access critical resources, educational content, and opportunities for personal and professional growth. Ultimately, this will help bridge the digital divide and promote greater equity in access to knowledge and development tools. Through collaboration with both local and international partners, we will improve the effectiveness and inclusivity of our interventions, making them more impactful across diverse cultural contexts. Strategic partnerships will be key to ensuring the long-term sustainability of our work. By building strong relationships with local organizations, youth clubs, and other stakeholders, we will be able to leverage additional resources, expertise, and networks, creating a collaborative ecosystem that supports our initiatives. These partnerships will enhance our ability to foster innovation and sustainable development, increasing the scope and sustainability of our work.

The global perspective gained from this project will also enrich our organization's internal culture. Working with diverse groups and organizations will broaden our international vision, strengthening our ability to adapt to different contexts and identify new opportunities for growth. This will lead to the development of innovative and impactful programs that are better equipped to address the complex needs of young people.

What are the skills and experience of key staff/persons involved?

Mr. Arman Grigoryan is a Presidium member of FYCA, where he works to support youth development and engagement initiatives at the national level. Arman Grigoryan served as Co-President of MIJARC Europe (International Movement of Catholic Agricultural and Rural Youth) from 2017 to 2020, contributing to the organization's mission of empowering rural youth across Europe. His work has been instrumental in developing cross-cultural dialogue and fostering partnerships between youth organizations across Europe.

Ms. Emily Ter-Hovhannisyan is the Secretary-General of the FYCA. In this pivotal role, she leads the organization's strategic efforts by supporting the Board's initiatives through comprehensive project planning, monitoring, and coordination of youth projects at local, regional, and international levels. Specifically, she oversees the International Communication and Project Development and Management Department, which is responsible for driving the federation's cross-border youth engagement and collaborative initiatives. Her responsibilities encompass developing and managing international projects, facilitating communication with global youth organizations, and ensuring the strategic alignment of FYCA's objectives with broader youth development goals.

Ms. Sona Hambarzumyan is a first Secretary of FYCA. Sona is a key professional responsible for developing regional integration initiatives and organizing strategic projects in the far regions of Armenia. Her role focuses on coordinating regional development efforts, with a specific emphasis on projects targeting remote and less-developed areas of the country. As the primary lead for regional projects, Sona plays a crucial role in bridging local community needs with broader regional development strategies, helping to promote economic and social advancement in Armenia's peripheral territories. She also coordinates the relations and cooperation with the displaced and youth of Diaspora Armenian communities.
